We hold bi-monthly meetings at the practice for patients to attend.

- Dec 16; **228 DNA** Out of 6,225 appointments offered*



Shingles Vaccinations

This year's program is for patients aged 70 & 78 on 1st Sept 2016 (and for those aged 71, 72 or 79 who haven't been vaccinated yet):

- Patients aged 70 to 74 years (02.09.1942 to 01.09.1946)**
- Patients aged 78 and 79 years(02.09.1936 to 01.09.1938)**


Shingles can occur at any age, with the highest incidence seen in older people: over 50,000 cases of Shingles occur in older people aged 70 and above each year. The incidence and severity of Shingles increases with age and this is thought to be associated with waning immunity. If you fit the age range criteria, we recommend that you have this vaccine to receive the best possible health care. Please make an appointment with the Nurse or ask for it when you have your Flu vaccine.

Community Non Obstetric Ultrasound Service

HealthHarmonie are a Community Ultrasound Service provider and currently operate across all of Nottinghamshire CCG areas.

Through the GP referral system they are now offering an ultrasound service at Ashfield Medical Centre on King Street, in the centre of Sutton-in-Ashfield.

The average waiting time for patients is only 11 days, compared to secondary care which is on average between 3 and 6 weeks.

Have you registered for Online Services yet?

- Once registered, you can book and cancel doctors appointments, request your repeat medication and change contact details, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- It's easy to register; request a Registration Form from reception and bring your photographic ID in to the surgery, you must do this in person so we can verify your identity. You can also register your children under 14 years of age. The process takes 7 working days before you can pick up your login information.
- The first time you log in you will be asked to change the password to something you can remember.
- There is also an app for Android and Apple users, so you can access services from your smartphone.
